- Morning or Afternoon Placements

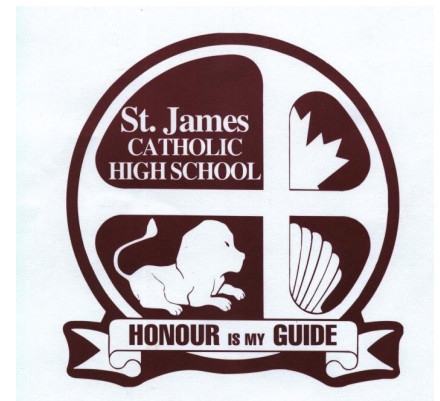

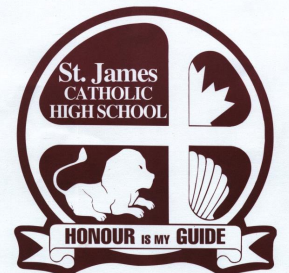

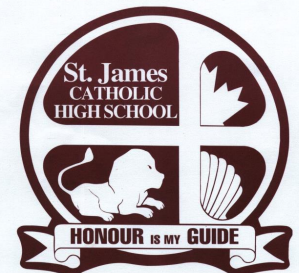
Summer School Co-op

- **Pick up application in Guidance**



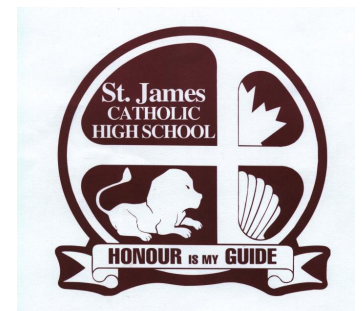
Specialist High Skills Major

eLearning Courses

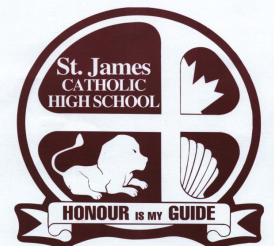
- Assignments submitted online

Things to consider in order to be successful...

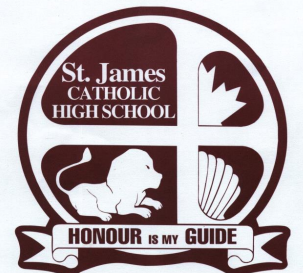
- Strong management skills
- Independent, self-disciplined
- Expertise in using the computer for email, word-processing, using the internet
- Expect 75 minutes of work per day
- Students have more flexible hours during the day as there is no scheduled class

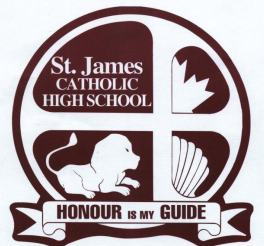

Dual Credits



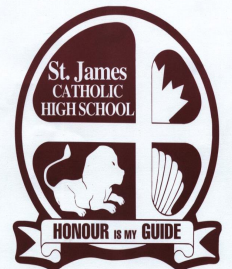
- This program provides Grade 12 students with the opportunity to attend and experience college

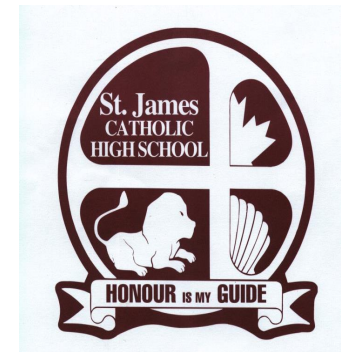

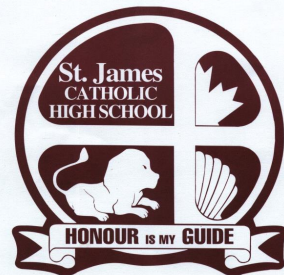
